Annual Evaluation by Faculty Members

March 2023

The college conducted a detailed evaluation of all the activities of the college for the academic year 2022- 2023. The faculty members being major stake holders in the Teaching Learning process were involved in evaluating the academic, co-curricular and extracurricular activities of the college. Each faculty member was given an envelope with an evaluation form that had to be resubmitted to the Principal and IQAC within a stipulated time. The form had both qualitative and quantitative questions with options for providing suggestions.

The major inputs derived from an objective analysis of the faculty evaluation are:

- There must be involvement of all faculty members in academic, co-curricular and extracurricular program facilitation.
- The medium of instruction ought to be predominantly English.
- Lessons plans and teaching notes must be evaluated by HoDs.
- Library stock must be enhanced to maintain the same as an optimal learning centre.
- There ought to placement and internship assistance to students within the network of Don Bosco institutions, sustained efforts to support slow learners and provision of effective add on programs.
- There must be strategies to improve admissions and student number.
- SODASHI 2k22 has been unanimously appreciated. The next edition must be bigger and better.
- Student assignments, projects and seminar presentations must be qualitative
- Semester plan must be adhered to. Internal examinations must be planned in advance.
- PTA Meetings have been very positive this year and helpful towards the Teaching Learning procedure.

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A Report on Student Evaluation – 2022-2023

The students of the college are the greatest stakeholders and the focus point of the entire Teaching – learning procedure. The college conducted a detailed analysis of the various aspects of the academic year 2022-2023 by collecting feedback from the students. This was done by the Principal using both a feedback form and descriptive feedback. The areas of feedback collection included academic aspects, university results, interaction with the Principal, teaching –learning experience, co-curricular and extracurricular activities. The data has been consolidated by the IQAC along with two senior faculty members.

The various aspects of data collected are depicted below followed by the qualitative assessment.

- A great majority of the respondents, over 65 % found events like College Day, Arts Day, Onam, Sports Day and Kerala Piravi a very positive experience.
- Sodashi 2k22 also got positive feedback and was quoted as a learning experience.
- 58% of the respondents have found the teachers and the teaching strategies effective and the academic ambience optimal.
- Co- curricular events like study tours, rural camps and NSS based extension programs have been lauded by students.
- Over 55% of the respondents found the Principal good and friendly, around 5% of students have responded that the Principal is strict, 20% of the respondents have rated the Principal as having a good personality and 3% of the respondents found the Principal impartial.
- The library as a learning centre has been appreciated by 40% of the students
- The politics free campus and the involvement of the Student Council have been found positive by 52% of students.

Some general suggestions provided by the students are:

- Create more attractive Campus (Sitting area, Small Park etc.)
- Reduce semester fees
- Consider reducing the duration of the daily assembly
