**BRIDGE COURSE REPORT**

**Title of the Event:** SKILL UP 2022

**Aim of the event:** To develop the communication skills, logical reasoning, soft skills, social and psychological wellbeing and the group dynamics of the students.

**Duration of the session:** 8 Days (22-08-2022 to 31-08-2022)

**Number of students participated:** 108

Skill Up 2022 is a bridge course for the first-year management quota UG and PG students organized by the Department of English in association with other departments of the Don Bosco College. The 8 days program began on 22-08-2022 and ended on 31-08-2022.

The programme was inaugurated by Rev. Dr. Fr. Johnson Ponthempilly, Principal Don Bosco College Sulthan Bathery. A detailed introduction to the bridge course was given by Ms. Anna Merin Scaria, Head, Department of English. The inaugural session was followed by the departmental sessions performed by various departments of the college. The sessions focused on the LSRW skills as well as other areas for the all-round development of an individual.

The morning sessions were engaged by the department of English. The sessions focused not only on the listening, speaking, reading and writing skills, but also the basic grammar which is a fundamental aspect of English language. It helped the students to have an idea about the base structure of using a language in different situation. Each session was introduced with proper learning aids along with activity worksheets for students. Practicing sessions, classroom activities and language games were also provided for the students to ensure their complete participation in the programme. As a part of developing the critical thinking, a movie was screened and students were asked to prepare a movie review for the same. The morning sessions were handled Ms. Smruthi, Ms. Arunima, Ms. Aiswarya and Mr. Amal.

Everyday the afternoon sessions were handled by Department of Psychology, Department of Commerce, Department of Social work, Department of Travel and Tourism, Department of Computer and Maths and Department of Management respectively. The departments engaged students with various games and activities which included mind games, co- ordination games and concentration games and also activities that helped to develop the group dynamics of the students. Students secured various prizes in the games and activities conducted by these departments.

The main objective of conducting these sessions was to make students confident in participating the activities, develop group dynamics and to enrich their skills through different activities. The students actively participated in the Skill Up programme. Feedbacks were also collected from the students regarding the course. Skill Up 2022 concluded on 31-08-2022 afternoon with a valedictory session. Prizes for the winners of various programs were also distributed on this day.

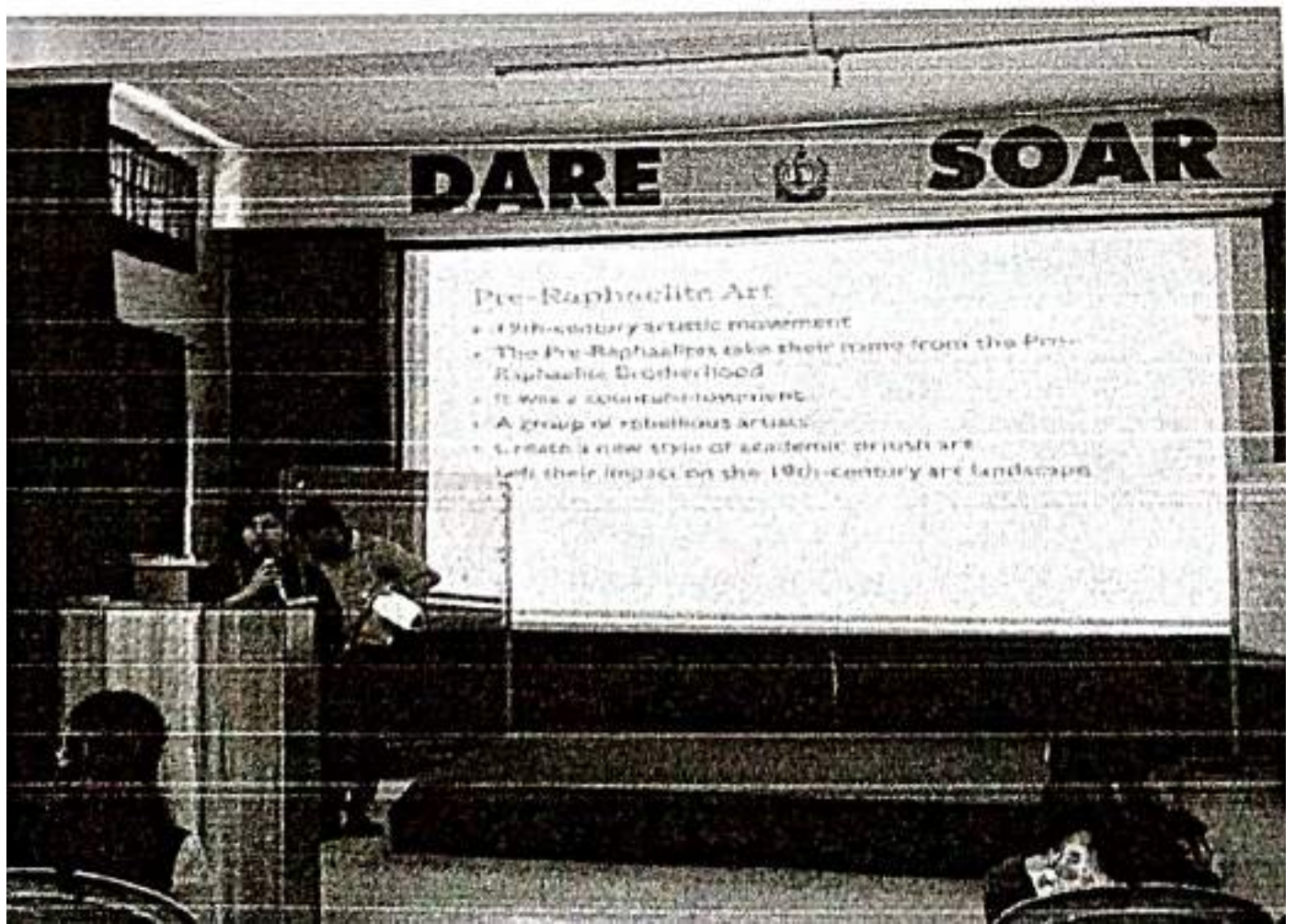

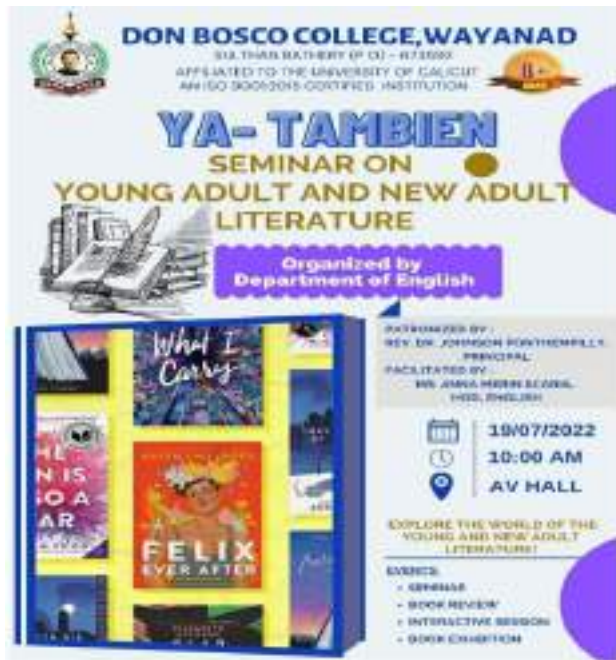
